Housing

On-Campus Options

The University offers on-campus housing, or students can receive a discounted rate for off-campus accommodations in selected motels and hotels during the 2011 summer session.

All registrations for on-campus housing are handled directly with the university housing office. An on-line summer housing application is available at www.dug.edu/residence-life/summermusicsschoolhousing. Please be aware that this also requires a separate payment.

On-campus housing rates are approximately \$19/night for a double room or \$25/night for a single room. Please check the website listed above for specific rates.
