The summer program **Strings Without Boundaries (SWB)** in partnership with **D'Addario Bowed Strings** invites you to compete for the opportunity to have your original tune arranged by four renowned performer-educators and performed by the **Strings Without Boundaries Eclectic Styles Orchestra** at Duquesne University summer 2012.

The winner will receive full tuition to **Strings Without Boundaries 2012** (performance track or teacher training track) courtesy of **D'Addario Bowed Strings**.

Submit an original melody and our stellar faculty — **Julie Lyonn Lieberman, Richard Greene, Matt Turner,** and **Randy Sabien**— will create a team arrangement of the winning tune in four styles: fiddle, rock, jazz, and world. The arrangement will be performed at SWB on Friday, June 29th, 2012 and video footage will be posted on the SWB and D'Addario Bowed Strings sites.

Deadline: March 1st, 2012. The winner will be announced on March 31st, 2012.

The arrangements of the winning entries will also be posted in PDF form on the D'Addario site, **The Lesson Room**, for three months as a free download for string teachers and players to be used in their string programs. A video of the performance will be posted on the SWB and D'Addario websites.

Who Can Enter: The competition is open to bowed string players of all ages, levels, and styles.

Guidelines: Write a catchy melody and submit it! Go to www.stringswithoutboundaries.com to download the entry form and guidelines. A tune-writing handout is also available there for download.

Strings Without Boundaries is at it again! In its 9th year, SWB was the first to offer fiddle, jazz, rock, and blues **ensemble-oriented** training in American and world styles! SWB was also the first to offer an **Eclectic Styles Teacher-Training Program** (for credit)! Now SWB is fostering the creation of original material in American fiddle, blues, jazz, rock, and world genres for bowed strings.

About the Arrangers:

Julie Lyonn Lieberman is the author of eight books and six DVDs distributed by Hal Leonard, nine eclectic style string orchestra scores for Alfred Publishing and three for Kendor. Creative Consultant to many prestigious music programs, she is an eclectic styles specialist and a D'Addario Elite Clinician.

Richard Greene, Grammy winner & one of the most innovative and influential fiddle players of all time, first attained prominence as a Bill Monroe Bluegrass Boy, then founded Seatrain (one of the earliest appearances of violin in rock music), The Greene String Quartet (Jazz & Americana), The Grass is Greener (Bluegrass), and other groups.

Randy Sabien is the author of the ground-breaking method *Jazz Fiddle Philharmonic*. He is the founding chair of the String Department at McNally Smith College of Music in St. Paul, Minnesota and a composer for Alfred.

Matt Turner, featured on over 100 recordings, is regarded as one of the world's leading improvising cellists. Equally adept in many styles, Turner performs in a number of styles.
